The Heart is Evil

(NKJV)

Rom. 8: 7-9

Because the carnal mind *is* **enmity against God** ["**hostile to** God"—*NIV*]; for it is not **subject** to the **law** of God, nor indeed can be. So then, those who are in the flesh **cannot** please God. But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, **if** indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you.

Jer. 17:9

The heart is deceitful above all things, And desperately WICKED; Who can know it?

Romans 7:18-25

For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells; for to will is present with me, but how to perform what is good I do not find. For the good that I will to do, I do not do; but the EVIL I will not to do, that I practice. Now if I do what I will not to do, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells in me. I find then a law, that EVIL is present with me, the one who wills to do good. For I delight in the law of God according to the inward man. But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? I thank God—through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, with the mind I myself serve the law of God, but with the flesh the law of sin.

Eccl. 9:3

This *is* an evil in all that is done under the sun: that one thing *happens* to all. Truly **the hearts of the sons of men are full of EVIL**; madness *is* in their hearts while they live, and after that *they go* to the dead.

Eph. 2:3

among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others.

Mark 7: 21-23

For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed EVIL thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lewdness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness. All these evil things come from within and defile a man.

Romans 6:6

knowing this, that our old man was crucified with *Him*, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin.

Rom. 3: 9-12

What then? Are we better *than they*? Not at all. For we have previously charged both Jews and Greeks that they are all under sin. As it is written: "**There is none righteous, no, not one**; There is none who understands; There is none who seeks after God. They have all turned aside; They have together become unprofitable; **There is none who does good, no, not one**."
